



GIVING THROUGH IRA DISTRIBUTION

If you are 72 years or older, you can make a tax-free donation directly from a traditional or Roth IRA, up to \$100,000. Your gift benefits Parks & Trails Foundation while reducing your adjusted gross income, which can lower your tax bill.

How it works

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) permits annual direct transfers of up to \$100,000 (per individual) of tax-deferred IRA savings.

To make a distribution, contact your IRA administrator and provide instructions in writing to transfer the amount you wish directly from the IRA to the Parks and Trails Foundation.
